# From the President

2006 was a tipping point both at home and nationally, with a tax showdown in Maine and a dramatic realignment in Washington. TABOR's defeat and the upheaval in Congress suggested that many Americans are wary of simplistic solutions to the complex challenges of twenty-first century life.

Throughout the year, our grantees, old and new, made healthy progress on many of those challenges, helping defeat TABOR, making headway toward a living wage, getting toxic waste removed from communities, criminalizing hate crimes against the homeless, mounting successful challenges against big box stores, stopping aerial blueberry spraying, promoting affordable housing, dealing with lead paint in homes, standing up for immigrant rights, and much more.

And at Maine Initiatives, we reached a major tipping point ourselves. Because we're about moving money to water the roots of change, our big focus was fundraising. We concluded **Tipping Point: The Campaign for Maine Initiatives**, raising nearly \$2.5 million in three years to establish The Endowment at Maine Initiatives and also putting significant additional dollars into our program work. The interest from the endowment is paying a portion of our operating costs, allowing more of the money we raise annually to go directly to support community organizations.

The campaign attracted donations from over three hundred people and businesses, and several foundations joined in as well. I want to acknowledge here two foundations that bookended the effort handsomely. We could never have undertaken the challenge without a start-up grant from Jessie B. Cox Charitable Trust, and it was a generous grant from the Maine-based River Rock Foundation that took us over the top late last fall.

Long-term, our goal is to build the endowment to the point where it underwrites all our operating costs. To get there, in 2006 we launched **Cloud Seeders**, our new planned giving society. Through Cloud Seeders, you can use planned gifts and bequests to leave a legacy of equity and justice.

Our thanks go out to all of you who pooled your dollars for social justice through Maine Initiatives, with a special tip of the watering can to those who took part in Tipping Point. Together, we're changing Maine.

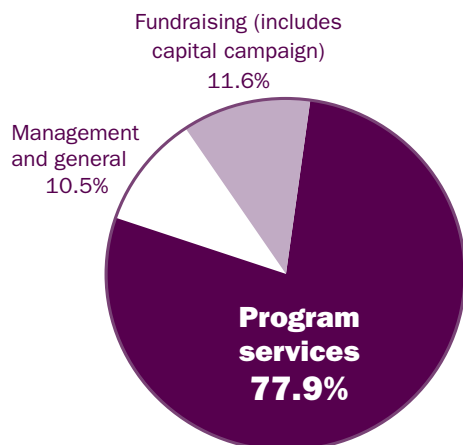
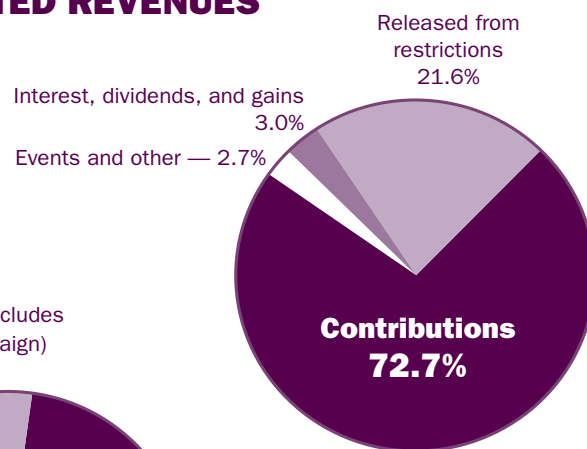
